RESULTS OF EXAMINATION

The lengths of wire (Submissions 1 and 4) were examined microscopically for the presence of comparable toolmarks and compared to the tools (Submission 6) with negative results.

Nails submitted (Submissions 3 and 4) have manufacturing marks of possible value to identify them to nails manufactured on the same machine.
