REPORT OF INTERVIEW

With Kerry Glasheen, on November 4, 1991 at 1210 hours, at 3A Massasoiet St., Medford, Massachusetts, by Special Agents Thomas D'Ambrosio and Dennis Leahy, Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco and Firearms Mr. Glasheen states as follows:

Mr. Glasheen said that he had worked for "Austin" in Hopkington and that they never turned the alarm to the bunker on and left the magazines open also that there was a lot of cocaine being sold by the blasters "eight balls" and 1/4s and up, particularly Atlantic Construction employees. Glasheen also said that there was no market for selling explosives and that the explosives that were taken were just to play with, i.e., fishing. Mr. Glasheen exhibited a basic understanding of explosives.

Mr. Glasheen also said that everybody had a key, including all the old employees at Austin. Mr. Glasheen said that he had worked for Fontani (Phonetic) Construction in Framingham and at his residence and at both locations had sprayed cans.

Mr. Glasheen, when asked, said that he did not know a DeSangro, knew a possible Fanning who was a fat blaster, did not a Rothman and knew Thomas Shay only from TV.
