Before we search your premises, it is my duty to advise you of your rights under the fourth amendment to the Constitution. You have the right to refuse to permit us to enter your premises. If you voluntarily permit us to enter and search your premises any incriminating evidence that we find may be used against you in a court or other proceedings. Prior to permitting us to search, you have the right to require us to secure a search warrant. You have the right to stop the search at any time, if you permit us to search with your consent.

No promises or threats have been made to me and no pressure or force of any kind has been used against me.
