9. DETAILS:

On January 31, 1992, Special Agent Thomas E. D'Ambrosio contacted Donna Shea via telephone at approximately 3:30pm. The purpose of the telephone call was to verify a statement made by Alfred Trenkler, that he had paid Shea \$500.00. Shea verified the payment, stating that it was against the \$5000.00 owed to her by Trenkler from the business they had jointly owned. Shea stated that she had heard that search warrants were being served on locations associated with Alfred Trenkler. She stated that she learned of this from a telephone call she received from Trenkler earlier that day. She stated that she had made a tape recording of a telephone conversation between Trenkler and herself, where Trenkler discusses the bomb he built in 1986. She stated that she made the tape as insurance against Trenkler ever trying to involve her in that incident, and that she still has the tape.

On February 3, 1992, Special Agent Thomas E. D'Ambrosio was contacted via telephone by Donna Shea. She stated that she knows that several people were being served with grand jury subpoena's and she was inquiring as to whether she was going to be served. She was told that at this time there was no subpoena issued for her.

On February 4, 1992, Special Agent Thomas E. D'Ambrosio briefly interviewed Alfred Trenkler while he was at the ATF Boston Field Division office. Present at the time were SA's Leahy and LaCourse. SA D'Ambrosio pointed out to Trenkler the continual inconsistencies in the statements he has made between November and this date. Trenkler stated that he was confused in November when interviewed and that since that time he has had time to think about his relationship with Tom Shay. Trenkler stated that he befriended Shay in June 1991 and brought him home to 133 Atlantic

Street Quincy, MA at that time. He stated that he remembers the time frame because his roommate, John Cates was in Europe on vacation at the time. Trenkler further stated that shortly after, he was contacted by Shay, and drove Shay to a clothing store in Rhode Island. He then said that he has avoided contact with Shay but did admit that Shay has attempted to contact him. Trenkler repeatedly stated his innocence in this matter. Trenkler stated that he made the explosive device in 1986 because it contained a M-80 and could not have possibly injured anyone. He stated that he would never have made anything that contained dynamite.

At that point SA D'Ambrosio left the conference room, so SA's Leahy and Lacourse could conclude their discussion with Trenkler.
