REPORT OF INTERVIEW

With Scott Douglas Critcher on February 3, 1992, at 2:00 P.M. at 222 Centre St, Quincy, MA by Special Agents Edmond G. Cronin and Sandra R. LaCourse of the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco and Firearms, Boston, MA. Mr. Critcher stated as follows:

Mr. Critcher stated that he lives at the above address with his brother and his brother's girlfriend. He stated that his telephone number is 471-6156. At the time of this interview, Critcher had a friend of his by the name of Stephen Murray. Murray was subsequently interviewed immediately after the interview with Critcher. At time of introduction with Critcher, another individual by the name of Kevin Beliveau was present and left as soon as he saw the reporting agents. Beliveau gave his name to Agent Cronin and then took off in a blue Ford LTD, MA. registration 715TNK.

Mr. Critcher stated he met Thomas Shay Jr. on Friday October 25, 1991 at the Store 24 on Washington St., Quincy, MA at approximately midnight. Critcher stated he is employed at the Store 24 and usually works from 4 P.M. to midnight. They walked from Store 24 to Quincy square. Critcher stated Shay Jr. gave him his name and address at that time. He related Shay Jr. told him he was living with his mother at the Falls in Quincy. Critcher also stated that Greg LNU, another employee at Store 24, was familiar with Shay Jr. Critcher stated Greg LNU works the midnight to 8 A.M. shift at Store 24. Critcher stated Shay Jr. came to a Halloween party he had at his house, 222 Centre St., on Saturday October 26, 1991.

DETAILS (Continued)

He stated Shay Jr. stayed in a corner of the house by himself for the most of the party. Critcher stated Shay left the party sometime after midnight. Critcher stated that he also saw Shay Sunday night (10/27/91) in the parking lot of Store 24.

Critcher stated he wrote to Shay Jr. three times while he was in jail, including sending him a birthday card. He stated he sent the letters to Shay Jr.'s mother's house. He stated he thought his mother took them to the prison. Critcher related he received a letter from Shay Jr. on Christmas Eve. Critcher attempted to find the letter he received from Shay Jr. but was unable to locate it.

Critcher stated the next time he saw Shay Jr. was when he came to the Store 24 on what he believes was New Years day. He related Shay Jr. told him that he got out of jail because a guy in Washington state sent him a personal check for \$100,000 for bail. Critcher stated that Shay had mentioned a court date of 1/17/92.

Critcher stated that around this time (New Year's Day), Shay came to his house with his mother and her boyfriend. He stated he remembered the mother talking about having been out drinking the night before. He stated that everybody crashed at his house for the night. He stated that the next day, they drove back to "the Falls" and stayed for a little while. Afterwards, Shay's mother stayed at the apartment while Thomas, his mother's boyfriend and he drove back to Critcher's apartment. Critcher stated that while at the apartment, he started to take down the Christmas tree and asked Thomas A. Shay to help. He stated that Shay Jr. refused to help and that an argument ensued over how Shay was self centered. Critcher stated that he then asked the mother's boyfriend to drive Shay Jr. home which he did. He stated that later on that night, Shay Jr. called him to apologize and to say that he was miserable. He stated that Shay didn't specifically state why he was miserable. Critcher stated that Shay is just a miserable person who makes those around him miserable. He stated that Shay's mother had also talked to him on the phone and inquired as to what had happened between the two.

Critcher stated that he and Shay Jr. spent two nights together in the same bed fully clothed. He stated that they were never sex partners. He also stated that he had never met Thomas Shay Sr.

Critcher stated that while Shay Jr. was in his home, Shay had called a couple of the news stations and told them the story that the police investigating the bombing had insulted and offended his friends just because they were gay. Critcher stated that he told Shay that that wasn't the case. He said that Shay had spoken to Charlie Austin, Channel 4 news reporter, who had told Shay that they weren't interested in the story.

Critcher stated that he found out about the bombing through reading about it in the newspapers the next day. He stated that Steve had called him up while he (Critcher) was working at Store 24 to tell him to read the newspaper. He stated that he may have also heard about it on the radio.
