REPORT OF INTERVIEW

With Dwayne Armbrister, on February 20th and 24th, 1992, at Radio Shack, 197 Massachusetts Ave, Boston, Massachusetts, by Special Agent Sandra LaCourse and Special Agent Dennis Leahy, Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco and Firearms, Boston Field Division. Mr. Armbrister states as follows:

Mr. Armbrister said that he is employed as a salesman by the Radio Shack Corp., and that on October 18, 1992, he entered into the computer information that created a sales slip. This slip had the name of an individual of "Sahy" and the last four telephone numbers of "3780" and that there were six items purchased. Armbrister gave the original sales slip to the above named agents. Armbrister when shown a photo spread of Thomas A. Shay (Jr) could not identify anyone. Armbrister when shown a photo spread of Al Trenkler identified Trenkler as having been in the store before. Armbrister when shown a "mug shot" of Thomas A. Shay (Jr) said that this person had been in the store before and said that this person wore jeans and a blue sweatshirt. Armbrister could not remember when Shay (Jr) was in the store.

Armbrister said that he left Radio Shack around January 2, 1992 as his grandfather had passed away in Miami, Florida and that he stayed in the Miami area till recently.
