ORDER TO SERVICE PROVIDER

THIS MATTER having come before the Court pursuant to the application of the United States for an order authorizing the continued interception of digital and alpha-numeric messages communicated electronically to a certain paging device leased from Metro Media Paging, Inc., 50 Soldiers Field Place, Brighton, MA, such device assigned telephone numbers (617) 532-2504 (for purposes of digital display of the calling telephone number) and 1-800-22ALPHA (for purposes of displaying alpha-numeric messages) and subscribed to by ARCOMM, Inc., 82 Broad St., Weymouth, MA, and used exclusively by Alfred W. Trenkler (hereinafter, the "Target Pager Device"), and the initial interception of wire communications ("voice mail") facilitated by means of telephone number (617) 553-0778, also assigned to the Target Pager Device, such interception to include, without limitation, retrieval of all voice mail messages remaining within the storage capacity of the voice mail function of the Target Pager Device as of the time of this Court's

allowance of this Application;

IT APPEARING that the Court, having reviewed the Application submitted by the Government in connection with the instant request and having found that it conforms in all respects to the requirements of Title 18, United States Code, Sections 2516 and 2518, has this 12 th day of March, 1992, signed and issued an order conforming to the provisions of Title 18, United States Code, Section 2518, authorizing Special Agents of the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, and Firearms to accomplish the aforesaid electronic and wire interception, and;

IT FURTHER APPEARING THAT Metro Media Paging, Inc., 50 Soldiers Field Place, Brighton, MA, is a provider of electronic and wire communication services within the meaning of Title 18, United States Code, Section 2510(15); and


IT FURTHER APPEARING that the applicant has requested that Metro Media Paging, Inc. be directed to furnish the applicant forthwith all information, facilities, and technical assistance necessary to accomplish this interception unobtrusively and with minimum interference to the service to be intercepted, the Court hereby ORDERS that Metro Media Paging, Inc. furnish the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco and Firearms such information, facilities and technical assistance necessary to accomplish the interception unobtrusively and with a minimum of interference to the services that are accorded persons whose communications are to be intercepted,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the furnishing of any such

facilities or technical assistance by Metro Media Paging, Inc., be compensated by the applicant for reasonable expenses incurred in providing such facilities or assistance; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the furnishing of said information, facilities, and technical assistance shall terminate thirty (30) days from the date of execution of this Order unless otherwise ordered by this Court; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this Order be sealed and that Metro Media Paging, Inc., its agents and employees shall not disclose to the listed subscriber(s) for the said telephone numbers or facilities or to any other persons the existence of the Order or this investigation until otherwise ordered by the Court.
