

IT IS ORDERED:

1. (a) Defendant shall file all motions on or before October 21, 1992.
 - (b) The Government shall respond to all motions of the defendant on or before October 29, 1992.
 - (c) All motions and responses in opposition thereto shall be accompanied by written memoranda stating the reason for the motion or opposition and citations of relevant authority.
2. Trial is scheduled to commence on Monday, November 23, 1992 at 9:00 A. M. in Courtroom 3, John W. McCormack Post Office and Court House, Boston, Massachusetts.

3. Not later than three business days prior to the date of trial, counsel for the Government and defense counsel shall:
 - (a) Exchange proposed written stipulations of fact.
 - (b) File all proposed questions each requests the Court direct to the jury panel during voir dire examination.
4. No later than the first day of trial and before impanelling the jury, the Government shall submit to the Court in triplicate, with additional copies for defense counsel, a list of its witnesses, including their residence.
5. Unless the Court grants leave to file written requests to the jury later, counsel for all parties shall file such requests on the first day of trial.
6. All parties shall, prior to the commencement of the trial, mark for identification purposes all proposed exhibits and material to be used or offered during the trial. On the first day of trial, each party shall file those copies of a listing of such proposed exhibits.
