Tom Shay, Sr. called today to say the following:

1. He vigorously denies ever sexually abusing Tommy. He called Tommy's accusation "an out-and-out lie,"
2. His daughter Paula recently told him that she had been raped as a child by their Uncle Stan (now deceased), as had her sister Amy. Paula also said that she had been sexually abused by a neighbor in Hyde Park.. Mr. Shay claimed no previous knowledge of these events.
3. Mr. Shay believes that his ex-wife, Nancy Shay, is a "liar" and is not telling us the truth about Tommy's involvement in the bombing. He also said that Tommy, and his daughters Paula and Amy have difficulty telling the truth.
4. Tommy worked at Bradlee's in the Dedham Mall back in 1988/89 for a short period of time. There is a Radio Shack store directly across from Bradlee's.
5. Mr. Shay reiterated what Tommy said to him when he went to visit Tommy at the jail back in early November, 1991: "Dad, where did you go Saturday night?" Nancy Shay also later made the statement to Mr. Shay, "I should have stayed with Tommy Saturday night."
