Report of Interview

With William Cody, Dexter Corporation  
 Magnet Materials Division  
 on November 19, 1991, at 1:00 p.m.  
 at Fortune Drive, Billerica, MA  
 by Special Agents Dennis P. Leahy  
 and Edmond G. Cronin of the  
 Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco and Firearms  
 Mr. Cody stated as follows:

Mr. Cody stated the Dexter Corporation sells magnets to the Defense Industry and the Central Intelligence Agency. Cody stated that the holding power of a magnet is measured in pounds and that it is also a function of the thickness of the steel of the car body. Cody stated one of the magnets in question was an Eclipse Button magnet catalogue number E821. He related that the Button magnets are very brittle and hard. He stated the composition of the magnet is aluminum, nickel and cobalt known in the industry as Alnico. Cody stated that the steel on the underside of an automobile would show scrape marks before any scrapes would show up in the magnets. Cody related the magnets would break away from a surface they were glued to before a magnet would snap.

Cody related that no U.S. manufacturer cuts bevels into Button Magnets. The only manufacturer that cuts magnets is Eclipse Magnets, Vulcan Road, Sheffield S9 LEW, England, and that they are a division of James Neil Tools Ltd. Cody related that Button Magnets that are blue in color are distributed only by the Edmunds Scientific Company, 101 E. Gloucester Pike, Barrington, N.J. USA 08007-1380.
