AFFIDAVIT OF MICHAEL Z. BURNETT

I, Michael Z. Burnett, hereby depose and say the following:

1. I am a litigation paralegal employed by the law firm of Mahoney, Hawkes & Goldings.

2. I was requested by Attorneys Morris M. Goldings and Amy J. Axelrod to make inquiries to various state and federal correctional facilities and governmental agencies regarding the incarceration history of William David Lindholm, inmate number 17784038 ["Lindholm"].

3. The Schuylkill Federal Correctional Facility in Minersville, Pennsylvania, informed me that Lindholm was defined as an "administrative admission" on September 6, 1991, which is apparently the term employed for someone who enters the federal correctional system. His original sentence was for ninety seven (97) months.

4. The Federal Correctional Institution at Three Rivers, Texas, informed me that Lindholm was incarcerated from September 25, 1991, until October 11, 1991, at FCI El Reno, Oklahoma. Thereafter, he was incarcerated from October 11, 1991, until March 15, 1993, at FCI Big Springs, Texas.


However, during that time Lindholm was also in "transit facilities" between January 25, 1992, and January 22, 1993. I was unable to determine which facilities Lindholm was in during that time period.

5. The Plymouth House of Corrections confirmed that Lindholm was in Plymouth from December 17, 1992, through December 23, 1992, when he was transferred to the custody of the United States Marshall.

6. Lindholm was incarcerated at FCI Schuylkill, Pennsylvania, from March 22, 1993, until September 30, 1994, when he was released on "good conduct." During his tenure at the Schuylkill Federal Correctional Facility, Lindholm was also on a federal writ from October 12, 1993 until December 10, 1993.

7. The United States Marshall's Services Headquarters in Arlington, Virginia would neither admit nor deny that William David Lindholm was in the federal witness protection program. I was informed that the United States Attorney's Office would know whether he had been placed into the federal witness protection program.
