## Report of interview

With John Mitzel, Manager, Glad Day Bookstore, at 673 Boylston St., Boston, MA at 1:00 P.M. by Special Agents Edmond G. Cronin and Sandra R. LaCourse Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco and Firearms Boston, MA.

Mitzel stated his date of birth is 1/7/48. Mitzel stated he was manager of the Glad Day Bookstore and that it was owned by Jerald Moldenhauer. Mitzel stated he was aware who Thomas A. Shay, Jr. was and that he had met him once in the Glad Day bookstore. Mitzel stated he met Shay in the bookstore several days after the bomb exploded in Roslindale. Mitzel stated he had been told by the bookstore staff that Shay had been in the store on numerous occasions and that he had always come in alone. Mitzel reviewed a photospread containing a photograph of Alfred W. Trenkler. Mitzel failed to identify anyone in the photospread. Mitzel stated the bookstore had chargecard transaction records and that two months records would contain approximately 240 pieces of paper.

Also interviewed was Jerald Moldenhauer, DOB: 8/9/46. Moldenhauer stated he lived at 32 Beaty Ave., Toronto, Canada. Moldenhauer stated he was the owner of the Glad Day Bookstore and requested a subpoena be served prior to turning over any documents to the government. Moldenhauer reviewed a photospread containing Trenkler and failed to identify anyone. Moldenhauer stated he had never seen Thomas Shay, Jr.
